## Feature Film (70mm, 35mm and 16mm) coproduction

The Chinese government has informed the Government of Canada that only the 19 Chinese production companies listed below may coproduce with foreign partners:

- 6. Nanjing Film Studio
- 7. Zhejiang Film Studio
- 8. Anhui Film Studio
- 9. Fujian Film Studio
- 10. Xiaoxiang Film Studio (in Hunan Province)
- 11.Zhujiang Film Studio (in Guangdong Province)
- 12. Guangxi Film Studio
- 13.E'mei Film Studio (in Sichuan Province)
- 14. Yunnan Nationality Film Studio
- 15.Xi'an Film Studio
- 16.Lanzhou Film Studio
- 17. Shenzhen Film Studio
- 18. Tianjin Film Studio
- 19. Tianshan Film Studio (in Xinjiang)

Please note that feature film co-productions with Chinese companies not listed above <u>will not be granted</u> official co-production status under the Canada-China audiovisual agreement.
